“ Two years ago I was delighted to be invited by Barnstormers to direct their production of *Kiss Me Kate* and I am now equally delighted to have returned to direct their pantomime, *Snow White*.

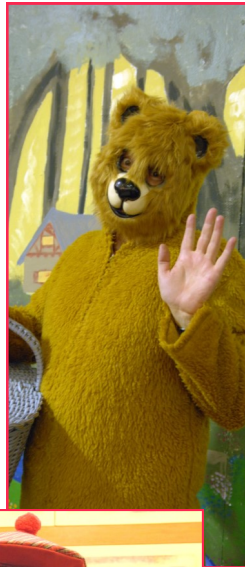
